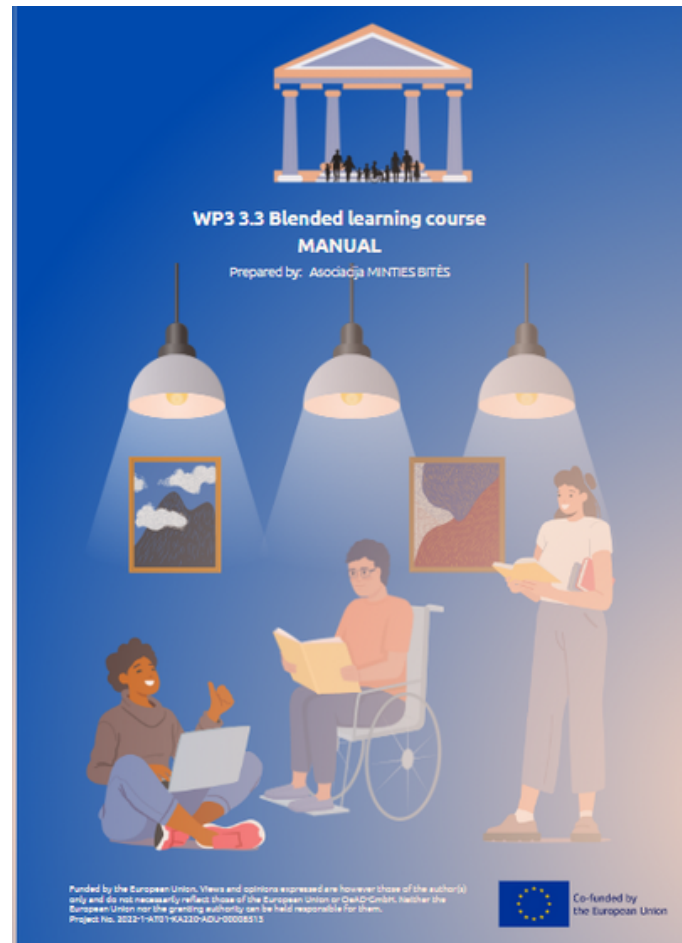
WP3: Blended learning course

After months of preparation, the INCLUDED partnership launched the blended learning course which is accessible in the [project elearning platform](#) in all partner languages.

The 80 hour blended learning course, targeted at adults with disabilities looking to pursue a career in the GLAM sector, features four modules:

- Module 1 (20 hours) - The digital GLAM-sector
- Module 2 (20 hours) - IT Security for the GLAM sector
- Module 3 (20 hours) - Communication and Cooperation
- Module 4 (20 hours) - Digital Content Creation

Each module comprises five online sessions, with the final one dedicated to self-reflection. Another five sessions are dedicated to face to face learning. A range of multimodal resources and attention to inclusive instructional design, were utilised to develop the course.



Manual for the blended learning course

A Manual was prepared and is available in the elearning platform of the project in all partner languages.

The Manual serves to introduce the 80 hour blended learning course and provides the content description for each of the four modules and its respective five sessions, composed of the hybrid, online and classroom resources. The manual focusses on intended learning outcomes and overview of Online and Face to face sessions.





TPM3 IN ITALY

The 3rd Transnational Project Meeting (TPM), was held in Campobasso, Italy, on April 11, 2024 and was hosted by the partner EUrelations at the meeting venue of JustMo'. Apart from project management, the partners reflected on the completed Work Packages 3 and discussed the next steps in Work Package 4. More specifically, the discussion spanned across the conduct of the progress of the INCLUDED Living Labs with multistakeholder involvement and the launch of the digital webinars as planned in April of 2024, led by VINCO. The agenda included updates on dissemination, increasing our reach on social media and monitoring quality evaluation and assurance.



In the afternoon, together with Teatro del Loto and Cooperativa Sociale Dialogo partners had the chance to know more about their amazing project regarding recovery of people with mental disabilities through theatre.

INCLUDED LIVING LABS

INCLUDED Living Labs are introduced in the project as part of the open innovation methodology adopted and foresees interaction between stakeholders through an interdisciplinary approach to cocreation practices and strategies. It is expected that municipalities, bodies representing people with disabilities, educational institutions, GLAM institutions, and more, will create these interdisciplinary networks (at a local level).
