WP4: Living Labs Handbook

Within the scope of the INCLUDED project, the coordinating institution, VINCO, have produced the Living Labs Handbook, which aims at defining basic cornerstones of the living labs approach, how to establish Living Labs, and its practical use for issues related to social inclusion.

Each partner has established interdisciplinary Living Labs for inclusive employment in the GLAM sector by conducting online conferences which aim at defining possible ways to support inclusive employment in the GLAM sector at a local and/or regional level.



The scope of the Living Labs Handbook is:

- Present the objectives and main indicators to be reached to ensure that all partners can start implementing their living labs at a local/regional level
- Define and explain the Living Labs approach to ensure that all partners think and work in a similar way.
- Present concrete examples of implemented Living Labs and the respective strategies employed.
- Present concrete ways to start networking and to establish Living Labs in the partners organisational environment.
- Utilise the Handbook as a means for implementation of Living Labs by external organisations to the project.





Dissemination events

Currently, the INCLUDED partnership is working towards the conduct of dissemination events.
All partners will be responsible for implementing a series of workshops ideally for GLAM professionals and the public, in each participating country.

The dissemination seminars aim to:

- Disseminate the guide for Inclusive Employment in the GLAM sector

- recruitment processes in the GLAM sector.
- Identify positive and transferable results and difficulties in the implementation of inclusive employment in GLAM.
- Propose improvements in scaling the project and refining future practice.
- Contribute to Project Evaluation report and dissemination of results to a wider audience and interested networks of GLAM professionals.
